- Diagnosis?
- Treatment?



Seborrhoeic eczema

- Inflammation to a commensal yeast
 - Leading to red scaly greasy patches in nasolabial fold/scalp/neck, groins, axilla
 - Also blepharitis
- Napkin area (versus atopic eczema)
- Treatment
 - Topical antifungal (miconazole) + corticosteroid
 - Daktacort[®]
