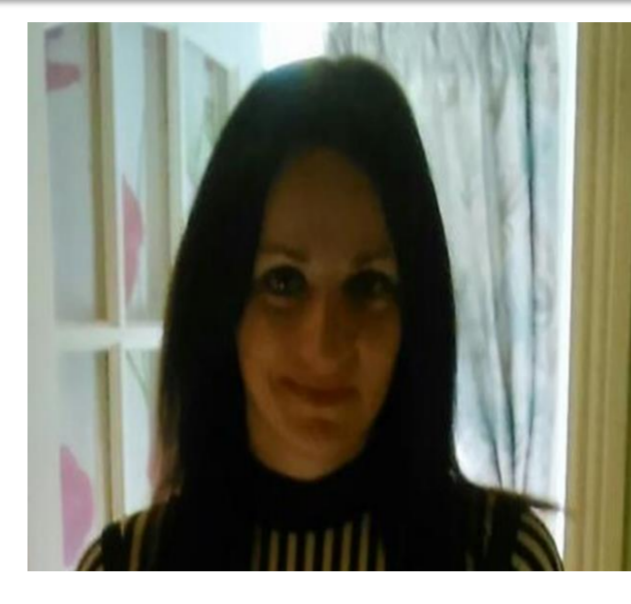

## Project Work Plan

- Create online educational tool(s) which highlight the importance of Multidisciplinary approaches to care for 1-2 emerging problems.
- Develop a webinar on 'Recent Advances in hepatitis C Care: Multidisciplinary perspectives'.
- Develop video clips which highlight the role of a range of health / social care professionals in the management of patients at risk of / infected with hepatitis C.

## Impact on Transition

- Develop Webinar(s) and clinical scenarios that help students learn complementary perspectives responsibilities and roles of healthcare professionals in medicine, pharmacy, psychology and nursing.
- Enhance the transition from student to practitioner with a focus on collaborative, intra-professional, integrative learning.
